HELFUL TIPS

1. PREP FOR PRIVATE LESSONS

Block in dates well in advance!
Think about what you want to
work on and what can realistically
be tackled in the time scheduled.

Review the material before the lesson! Consider preparing for your in-person private lesson with an Online Private lesson or a Video Submission.

2. FIND A STUDY-BUDDY

Small group lessons can be dynamic, fun and cost effective. Training partners who study together can help each other to improve.

3. BOOK A SERIES

If you book several lessons in advance, we can help you develop a plan for progress. By booking a series you may be eligible for a discount

4. TAG-TEAM TEACHING

Think about booking lessons with one of Sam's advanced students to learn choreography and master fundamentals—then book time with Sam for some fine tuning.

5. VID SUBMISSION - LIVE

Consider a couple of VIDEO SUBMISSION sessions before the ONLINE PRIVATE to consolidate what you have worked on.

6. SHORT SUBMISSIONS

If you make shorter submissions you'll receive quick, concise feedback that you can immediately integrate into your practice.

Private Lesson Guide

In-person Lessons

Many students have experienced accelerated progress from <u>private, small</u> <u>group, and online study</u> with Sam Masich.

Lesson topic, format and schedule can be tailored to meet individual needs. The opportunity for real hands on correction and direct feedback can be invaluable in cultivating higher skill levels.

- In-person private lessons are generally scheduled for an hour or 90 minutes but intensive blocks of study can also be accommodated.
- In-person private lessons can often be scheduled when Sam is on tour teaching a seminar in a location near you. Check the <u>Calendar</u> to see where they are and when.

Study groups

Groups of any size can also book Sam for closed sessions. Talk to your study-buddies and create a personalized program!

Online Lessons and Submissions

With so many ways to communicate and send information, there is no reason to let physical location be a barrier to learning. Sam offers online private training in two formats *Online Lesson* or *Video Submission*. Rates for In-person and Online sessions are the same.

1. Online Private

At an agreed upon time, we connect and have an online lesson by ZOOM, WeChat, Skype, FaceTime, etc. You are welcome to record your lesson.

2. Video Submission

You can submit videos of your practice via WeTransfer or DropBox or have a YouTube upload evaluated. Sam's response may be come in written form, an audio or video reply, or a combination of these.

There are two basic *video-submission formats:* 'General Feedback' and 'Specific Questions.' Which submission format you choose determines the kind of response you'll receive and the way you will be charged for your lesson. *Keep in mind* that you can submit just one or two minutes of video, work on that lesson for a month, and come back later for your next lesson.

Video Submission fees The fee for a general feedback lesson is \$20cN (\in 15) per minute of 'active video.' The fee for a Specific Questions lesson is \$20cN (\in 15) per question. Once funds have been received, the process of reviewing and responding will begin.
