

Applying to become a Registered Student of The Masich Internal Arts Method

When a student wishes to make a greater commitment to learning, practicing, and mastering curriculum from the Masich Internal Arts Method, he or she may apply to become a Registered Student. There are no fees involved in applying to become a Registered Student although financial responsibilities can come in the form of lesson/course fees, travel expenses, etc.

Registered Students receive ongoing personalized guidance from Sam Masich and his Instructor Students, and Indoor Students regarding practice of the Masich Internal Arts Method. The Registered Student Forum on WeChat features instruction and training tips from Sam Masich and gives advance notice of workshop dates, release of products, etc.

As a Registered Student:

1. You are committed to deepening your understanding of The Masich Internal Arts Method curriculum

2. You are committed to acting ethically both in and out of the practice

3. You agree to study personally, at least once per year, with an Instructor Student, Indoor Student, or with Sam Masich

4. You agree to supply a Curriculum Checklist that indicates what material you have already learned and periodically to update it

5. You may be asked to submit video demonstrations of aspects of The Masich Internal Arts Method curriculum

The application process

To become a Registered Student you must formally apply

1. You send a request to Masich Internal Arts for a Registered Student application form.

2. You will be sent a Registered Student application form and a Curriculum Checklist

3. You submit the Registered Student application form, the Curriculum Checklist and a letter explaining your motivations for applying. (These can be submitted electronically or on paper.)

4. You will receive acknowledgement of receipt of the application and whether or not it has been accepted. If accepted you will be added to a Registered Student register.
